- Directs technological research
- Preserves assets by implementing disaster recovery and back-up procedures and control structure
- Preparing an annual budget and scheduling expenditures
- Analyzing variances and initiating corrective actions
- Updating internal servers
- Evaluating new hardware

- Recruit and train systems administrators, computer programmers and data base administrators
- Attending educational workshops to maintain professional and technical knowledge
- Reviewing professional publications and establishing personal networks
- An IT/CIS manager also contributes to team effort by communicating job expectations and by accomplishing related results as needed Working overtime is common in this field, as an IT/CIS manager you are responsible for the overall performance of the electronic networks that allows the business to flow.
- An IT manager responsibilities might also be to upgrade the telephone systems depending on the companies needs

Team management skills are a must, every IT manager needs to have leadership skills, be a strategic thinker and have great communication skills. A balance between technical knowledge and management skills needs to be maintained, time management is also key.
